



## Hazardous Waste Classification Assessment

Understand the process involved in the classification of waste through the use of the Technical Guidance WM3 on the classification and assessment of wastes.

### Aims of the course

This course is based on the Technical Guidance WM3 developed by all four UK waste regulators and is therefore suitable for anyone within the UK. If you deal with hazardous wastes and need to ensure you are classifying them correctly and assigning the appropriate codes, this course will provide you with the appropriate skills and training.

### Learning objectives

By the end of this course you will:

- Understand the definition of hazardous wastes
- Be aware of the importance of, and to be able to use the European Waste Catalogue (EWC) to classify wastes
- Be able to find and use the relevant data sources to determine hazardous substances including the ECHA Classification and Labelling Inventory database
- Understand how and when to use hazard properties and hazard statements
- Understand what you need to assess Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs)
- Have a working knowledge of the guidance governing the coding and classification of hazardous wastes – including the latest WM3 guidance

### Who should attend?

Anyone classifying and coding hazardous wastes, including producers, operators of waste treatment or disposal facilities; and waste carriers and brokers.
