



## Hazardous Waste Regulations (General)

Understand the principles for a waste to be classified as hazardous and acquire a detailed understanding of the regulations controlling hazardous wastes.

### Aims of the course

Any organisation that is involved in producing, storing, collecting, transporting, recycling or disposing of hazardous waste must ensure it causes no damage or harm. This course explains which wastes are classified as hazardous and provides practical advice on how to comply with the regulations, including the consignment of hazardous wastes.

### Learning objectives

By the end of this course you will:

- Be able to use the List of Wastes / European Waste Catalogue (EWC) to determine whether a waste is classified as hazardous
- Be aware of the hazardous properties that can cause a waste to be classified as hazardous
- Be able to accurately complete a hazardous waste consignment note and understand the consignment note procedure
- Understand the key regulations relating to the management of hazardous wastes – including record keeping; quarterly returns; and the ban on mixing hazardous wastes
- Be aware of the difference in the regulations for the different nations of the UK (as applicable to the specific client)
- Be able to identify the impact of hazardous waste regulations on your activities – whether you are a waste producers, carrier or waste manager

### Who should attend?

This course is relevant to anyone responsible for dealing with or producing hazardous waste and anyone who should be aware of the classification of wastes and what types of wastes may be classified as hazardous.
